Mapping Retreat - Undergraduate

In this retreat, participants create a visual representation of how students progress through their degrees and achieve learning outcomes. Participants also identify common teaching and assessment methods used by program instructors.

Outcomes

- 1. Identify where program learning outcomes are introduced, reinforced, and where students become proficient as they progress through program modules.
- 2. Summarize common instructional and assessment methods used across the program.

| 2 hrs | Program Mapping Introduce CTL Program Mapping Tool. Map individual courses to program outcomes using the mapping tool. Identify instructional methods and assessments for each course. |
| 30 mins | Analyze Program Map Data Discuss module strengths, trends, and gaps observed in the data. |



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
